(B) Events of the Bible and Book of Mormon vis-a-vis the Archaeological Record.

(b) Not even (21) of the coins in the Book of Alma has ever been
found.
(c) Not one (22) or remains of a (23) in the Book of Mormon
has ever been located.
(d) Horses, pigs, donkeys, cows, and oxen, which are all mentioned in the Book
of Mormon, were not introduced into (24) until after the
arrival of (25) in (26). That's over a thousand years
after the close of the Book of Mormon. If these items actually were in Ameri-
ca would there not be some evidence uncovered by now
This is why no reputable (27) has ever verified any historical or
geographical statement found in the Book of Mormon.
(C) The Writings of the Mormon Church:
(1) Joseph Smith as Translator
(a) Joseph Smith claims to have translated the Book of Mormon in the late
(28) from some sacred (29) he unearthed near his
home in Palmyra, NY. The plates were said to be inscribed in
